

Ear Gluing

Your breeder is the first place to start when considering ear gluing. The Airedale's ears are glued into a position on the head to help train the ears to hold that nice position (pointing toward the corner of the eyes). This is done around the time the puppy is teething and discourages the ears from being held away from the head (fly-away ears). If you live close to your breeder, he/she will glue the ears. Otherwise, ask your breeder for a recommendation of someone in your area that can do the job. Veterinarians are often able to help in this matter.
